

How can I access my U: Drive from off campus?

With the migration of the U: drives to the new servers, SFTP access to U: drives will no longer be available.

For Faculty/Staff that need off campus access to their U: drives, they can use VPN (Virtual Private Network) to Remote Desktop into their campus computer or to ts1.fredonia.edu.
