

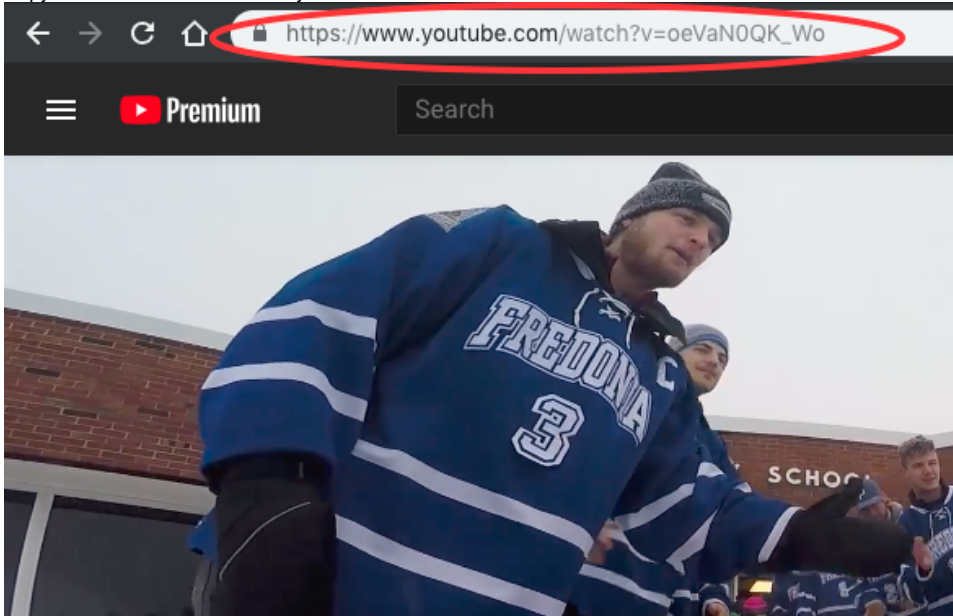
Drupal: Add a Video from YouTube or Vimeo

Step-by-step guide to embed a video from YouTube or Vimeo

1. Go to Youtube or Vimeo, find the video you would like to use.
2. Copy the URL for the video from your browser's URL field.



3. Open the Drupal page where you want to add the video.



4. Videos can be embedded in the Body area using the **Embed Media from External Sites** button. Paste the URL you copied from YouTube or Vimeo. Use these settings:

Embed Media Content (Photo, Video, Audio or Rich Content)

Paste a URL (shorted URLs are also supported) from one of the supported sites (e.g. YouTube, Flickr, Qik, Vimeo, Hulu, Viddler, MyOpera, etc.).

5. Click **OK** button to embed the video.
