

Drupal 8: Unpublish & Archive a Web Page

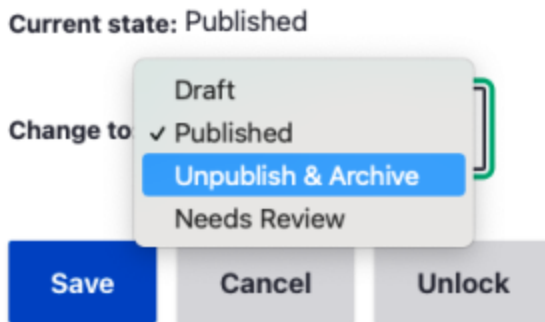
Unpublishing a Drupal page will hide it from the public until it is published again. You may use the following steps to disable or archive a web page that do not need to be displayed to the public, but you do want to retain the content for future reference.

Step-by-step guide

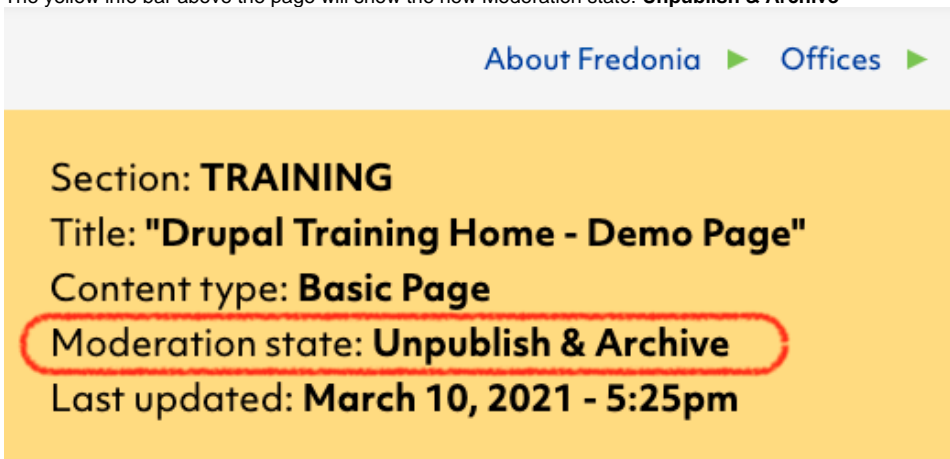
1. [Log into Drupal](#).
2. Visit the published page that you want to unpublish.
3. Click the **Edit** button in the lower right.



4. Scroll to the bottom of the page editor and set the **Change to:** state menu to **Unpublish & Archive** and click **Save**.



5. The yellow info bar above the page will show the new Moderation state: **Unpublish & Archive**



6. The page is no longer visible to the public.
